As part of this commitment, St. John's College offers a special financial aid program for students who are full-time primary or secondary school teachers. The Teacher's Grant provides a one-half tuition grant to pursue the college graduate program. Applicants who wish to be considered for the teacher grant program must complete this form and attach a letter from the principal of their school verifying their full-time employment as a teacher in the academic year prior to enrollment in the Institute.
