Full-time Lab Manager, Child Learning & Development Studies Lab, University of Texas at Austin, Austin, TX

The [Child Learning & Development Studies Lab](#) at the University of Texas at Austin, directed by Dr. Maria Arredondo, is hiring a full-time lab manager to start ASAP. The lab investigates the neuro-cognitive and socio-cultural mechanisms supporting bilingual infants and children in acquiring their languages. The lab uses experiments, eye-tracking, and functional near-infrared spectroscopy (fNIRS) methodologies. This position involves coordinating data collection, experimental design, supervising undergraduate research assistance, and lab administration. The position is ideal for someone that has experience or wants to learn eyetracking and fNIRS, especially someone that wants to continue to a doctoral program.

The Voyager Scholarship: The Obama-Chesky Scholarship for Public Service New Opportunity for Rising Juniors!

Application deadline: June 14, 2022 *Fast approaching!*

An increasingly globalized world needs young leaders who can bridge divides and help solve our biggest challenges together.

The Voyager Scholarship was created by the Obamas and Brian Chesky, Airbnb CEO, to help shape such leaders. Even though they come from different backgrounds, both the President and Brian believe that exposure to new places and experiences generates understanding, empathy, and cooperation which equips the next generation to create meaningful change.



This scholarship gives college students financial aid to alleviate the burden of college debt, meaningful travel experiences to expand their horizons, and a network of mentors and leaders to support them.

The award for Voyagers includes:

- Financial aid: of up to \$50,000 (\$25,000 per year) to cover “last dollar” financial aid to cover remaining tuition and/or living costs for junior and senior year of college.
- Summer Voyage: A budget of \$10,00 for students to design their own summer voyage between their junior and senior year of college.
- 10-year travel stipend: After graduation, Airbnb will provide the students with a \$2,000 travel credit every year for 10 years, totaling \$20,000. This will allow students to continue to broaden their horizons and forge new connections throughout their public service careers.
- Fall Summit: Voyagers will be invited to an annual Fall Summit which includes a meeting with President Obama, Brian Chesky, and other leaders.
- A network of leaders: Students will be invited to an ongoing speaker series, giving them access to a network of leaders.

One-Year Intensive Master's Degree in the Humanities, 20 Full-tuition Fellowships, Ralston College, Samos, Greece & Savannah, GA

Ralston College, a new institution of higher learning in Savannah, Georgia, is a revival and reinvention of the traditional university. Its first academic program is a one-year Master of Arts in the Humanities, focusing on the theme of 'the self' in philosophy, literature, and the arts.

The program is divided into four terms of intense intellectual work, first in Greece, then in Savannah. Students will face the challenge of discovering—and recovering—what the human self has meant, historically, across diverse times and cultures, and how this concept continues to inform the existential assumptions and convictions of our current moment.

Focusing, in 2022-23, on the theme of “the self,” the multidisciplinary curriculum will trace the origins and chronological development of the concept of the self through philosophy, music, architecture, art, and literature.
