At the intersection of Native American, Hispanic and Anglo cultures, the 400-year-old city of Santa Fe offers a stimulating environment for visitors to explore. Applauded for its food, art, shopping, architecture, and outdoor life, Santa Fe was named the best small city in America by Condé Nast's Traveler magazine in 2014.

The high desert city of Santa Fe is situated in the foothills of the majestic 12,000-foot Sangre de Cristo Mountains, along the Rio Grande. At an elevation of 7,000 feet, Santa Fe enjoys 320 sunny days per year and clear blue skies. Set high in the hills of the city's east side, St. John's College is located only three miles from the historic downtown Plaza and is within walking distance of four major museums and the famous Canyon Road art gallery district.

What follows are transportation options, entertainment venues, museums, restaurants, local accommodations, and more to help plan your trip to Santa Fe, or as it is affectionately called, The City Different. This compilation is provided by St. John's College as a convenience to our visitors, is not exhaustive, and should not be considered an endorsement of any business that is listed.

Also note that prices are subject to seasonal changes and may be discounted by various memberships. General tourist information may be obtained from the Santa Fe Convention and Visitor's Bureau.

If you are not used to living at altitude, it's recommended that you spend your first days in Santa Fe staying hydrated by drinking plenty of water and not engaging in strenuous physical activity.

# Transportation

## BY AIR

Two regional airports serve the Santa Fe area: the Albuquerque International Sunport (ABQ) and the Santa Fe Municipal Airport (SAF). Many carriers fly into ABQ; United and American airlines have limited flights into SAF.

## BY CAR

### **FROM ALBUQUERQUE**

Take 1-25 North for 60 miles

Take Exit 284, Old Pecos Trail

Go north (left) on Old Pecos Trail

Take slight right at the third light to stay on Old Pecos Trail

Turn right at Armenta (third stoplight)

Turn left at Camino Corrales (first stop sign)

Turn right at Old Santa Fe Trail (first stop sign)

After 1 mile, turn left at Camino del Monte Sol (first stop sign)

Turn right on Camino Cruz Blanca

St. John's College is on the right after the tennis courts

### **FROM TAOS**

Take U.S. 84/285 South

When entering Santa Fe, stay right and follow signs for 1-25/St. Francis Drive—84/285 becomes St. Francis Drive)

Turn left on Alameda

After 2.5 miles, Alameda will curve right and become Camino Cabra

Turn left just past Los Miradores

(residential development on left) onto Camino Cruz Blanca

St. John's College is on the right after the tennis courts

### **FROM LAS VEGAS OR CLINE'S CORNERS**

From Las Vegas, take I-25 South

From Cline's Corner, take U.S. 285 North to I-25 South

Take Exit 284, Old Pecos Trail

Go north (left) on Old Pecos Trail

Take slight right at the third light to stay on Old Pecos Trail

Turn right at Armenta (third stoplight)

Turn left at Camino Corrales (first stop sign)

Turn right at Old Santa Fe Trail (first stop sign)

After 1 mile, turn left at Camino del Monte Sol (first stop sign)

Turn right on Camino Cruz Blanca

St. John's College is on the right after the tennis courts

## PARKING

Parking is available in the Visitor Parking/Atalaya Trail lot, the first left when entering campus.

## BY TRAIN

Eastbound and westbound Amtrak trains stop at the Lamy, NM station, 17 miles from Santa Fe. The Lamy Station Shuttle runs between Lamy and Santa Fe. Shuttle reservations should be made in advance and drop-off/pick-up location should be stipulated. **505-982-8829**

The New Mexico Rail Runner Express runs between Albuquerque and Santa Fe. Exit at the last stop, the Santa Fe Depot. A taxi will be needed to transport you to campus. See Rail Runner or call **866-795-RAIL** for more information.
