

St. John's College 2025-26 Dependent Student Verification Worksheet

What Is Verification?

Your 2025-26 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, the government may ask you to confirm the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Office will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit them to the Financial Aid Office at St. John's College. Please provide the required information as quickly as possible because your financial aid cannot be finalized until verification has been completed. What Are the Steps?

1. If requested, please include any other requested tax documents such as W-2 forms or tax transcripts. Please note that a tax return (often the 1040) is not a tax transcript. Tax transcripts may be requested here: irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript.

2. Please write student's name on tax return transcript.

- 3. Complete and sign this worksheet you and at least one parent must sign.
- 4. Review all information sent from the Financial Aid Office and the second page of this worksheet to see if you need to submit other documentation.
