

St. John's College Graduate Institute Intercampus Transfer Application

To ensure the greatest possible likelihood that your intercampus transfer request can be met, **please submit this application form to both campuses no later than 60 days before the beginning of the semester in which you wish to transfer** (i.e., by June 25 for Fall, by November 5 for Spring, April 10 for Summer). Applying to transfer does not guarantee enrollment; therefore, it is best to submit this application as early as possible. Students who request to change campuses closer to the semester start date risk forfeiting \$50 of the advance tuition deposit.

Any student in good academic standing and with no outstanding balance on his/her student account may transfer between the Santa Fe and Annapolis campuses. If the transfer request is approved, then your official academic records will be sent to the campus to which you will transfer as soon as enrollment has taken place. From that point onwards, your academic records will be maintained on that campus unless you transfer back to the original campus. The campus where you complete your last requirements will be the campus through which your St. John's degree is awarded.

If you receive financial aid, notify the Financial Aid Offices on both campuses (Annapolis 410-626-2502, Santa Fe 505-984-6058) to seek guidance from an expert in that area.
